

Crochet pattern Soohorang

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Materials:

Cotton in the following colors:

- White 1 ball
- Black 1 ball
- Pink (a little bit, just for the nose)
- Cream (a bit only for the piece on the head)

1 pair of safety eyes: black 8 mm
fiberfill

crochet hook size 2,5 mm and 3 mm
needle and scissors
stitch marker

Abbreviations: (USA)

Sc = single crochet
St = stitch
Inc = increase
Dec = decrease
Ss = slip stitch
Dc = double crochet
Hdc = half double crochet
Ch = chain stitch
Tog = together

Foot and Leg (make 2):

Rnd 1: with white and hook size 3 mm, ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from the hook (6)
Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around (12)
Rnd 3: (sc in nex st, 2 sc in next st) around (18)
Rnd 4: (2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) around (24)
Rnd 5: working in back loops only: sc in each st around
Rnd 6: sc in next 10 sts, (sc next 2 sts tog) 4 x, sc in next 6 sts. (20)
Rnd 7: (sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 2 sts) 2 x, (sc next 2 sts tog) 5 x, sc in next 2 sts (13)
Rnd 8-15: sc in each st around
For first leg, join with ss in first st. fasten off
For second leg, do not fasten off



Body:

Rnd 1: Hold legs together with upper inner thighs together and toes pointed forward. Insert hook in center on innermost thigh of the first leg, pull out the loop from the second leg, sc in

same st (do not count this st: just for connecting the legs together), sc in next 12 sts on second leg (mark first st), sc in next 12 sts on the first leg. Stuff (24)



Rnd 2-10: sc in each st around

Rnd 11: (sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 2 sts) around (18)

Rnd 12: (sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next st) around. Leave long tail end for sewing, fasten off (12)
Stuff body

Head:

Rnd 1: with white and hooksize 2,5 mm, ch 2, 6sc in second ch from the hook (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) around (18)

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 sts, 2sc in next st) around (24)

Rnd 5: (2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts) around (30)

Rnd 6: (sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st) around (36)

Rnd 7: (2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts) around (42)

Rnd 8: (sc in next 6 sts, 2sc in next st) around (48)

Rnd 9: (2 sc in next st, sc in next 7 sts) around (54)

Rnd 10 – 16: sc in each st around

Rnd 17: sc in next 7 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 7 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 11 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, (sc in next 7 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) 2 x (48)

Rnd 18: sc in next 6 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 9 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 6 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, (sc in next 6 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) 2 x (42)

Rnd 19: sc in next 5 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 3 sts, (sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 6 sts) 2 x , sc next 2 sts tog, (sc in next 5 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) 2 x (36)

Rnd 20: sc in next 4 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 5 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 4 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, (sc in next 4 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) 2 x (30)

Rnd 21: sc in next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, (sc in next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) 2x, (sc in next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) 2 x (24)

Rnd 22: (sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 2 sts) around (18)

Stuff half of the head, place safety eyes between rnds 9 and 10 (approx.)

Rnd 23: (sc in next st, sc next 2 sts tog) around, join with ss in first st, fasten off (12)

Stuff head tightly

Snout:

(turn after every row)

Rnd 1: with cream and hooksize 2,5 mm, ch 6, turn 5 sc (5)

Rnd 2 – 5 sc (5)

Rnd 6: inc, 3 sc, inc (7)

Rnd 7 – 8: sc (7)

Rnd 9: inc, 5 sc, inc (9)

Rnd 10: sc 9

Rnd 11: inc, 7 sc, inc, (11)

Rnd 12 -13: 11 sc

Rnd 14: inc, 9 sc, inc (13)



sc around the entire piece

fasten off and leave a tail for sewing. Sew snout piece in the center of the head (photo) with the widest part up.

Embroider the nose with pink and black yarn (photo) and embroider the mouth and eyebrows with black yarn



Ears (make 2):

Rnd 1: With white and hooksize 3 mm, ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from the hook (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) around (18)

Rnd 4 -6: sc around (18)

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing

With black:

Rnd 1: ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from the hook (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Fasten off and insert the black part in the white part of the ear

Sew the ears on the head.



Arms (make 2):

Rnd1: with white and hooksize 3, ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from the hook (6)

Rnd 2: (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) around (9)

Rnd 3 – 9: sc in each st around. Stuff

Rnd 10: (2sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) around (12)

Rnd 11 – 12: sc in each st around

(you could fold the arm and crochet the opposite stitches together)

Fasten off, leave a tail and stuff the arm. sew to body

Tail:

Rnd1: with black and hooksize 3, ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from the hook (6)

Rnd 2: (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) around (9)

Rnd 3 – 4: sc around

Rnd 5-18: change to white, sc around

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing. Sew the tail to the body



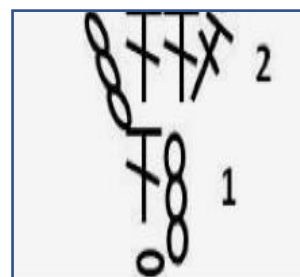
Black Triangles to decorate:

Larger triangle: (12 pieces)

With black and hooksize 2,5 mm

Ch 4, dc in the first sc from the chain (photo)

Turn and ch 3, 3 dc, fasten off



Smaller triangle: (7 pieces)
Ch 4, hdc in first sc from chain
Turn and ch 2, 2 hdc, fasten off

Sew the smaller triangles on the tail (3) and arms (2 on each arm)
Sew the larger triangles on legs (3 on each leg) and head (3 on each cheek)

For decoration you can use embroidery thread to create the Olympic circles on the body
