Egg cosy

Materials:

Yarn

You can use any cotton yarn from your stash

- hooksize 2,5 mm

Abbreviations (US)

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dec = decrease

inc = increase

The house is crocheted in rows. Turn after every row and start the row with ch1. Windows, door and chimney are crocheted in rows as well. The house consists out of two parts (front

and back) which you sew (or crochet) together after finishing the decoration of the front panel. Decoration can be sewed or glued on the front part. The bottom is left open because this house can keep your egg warm!

Pattern

House (2x):

Ch 20 + 1 (from now crochet ch1 after every row and turn)

Row 1-14: 20sc (20sc)

Row15: *change color*, inc 2x, 16sc, inc 2x (24sc)

Row 16: 24sc (24sc)

Row 17: dec, 20sc, dec (22sc)

Row 18: dec, 18sc, dec (20sc)

Row 19: dec, 16sc, dec (18sc)

Row 20: dec, 14sc, dec (16sc)

Row 21: dec, 12sc, dec (14sc)

Row 22: dec, 10sc, dec (12sc)

Row 23: dec, 8sc, dec (10sc)

Row 24: dec, 6sc, dec (8sc)

Row 25: dec, 4sc, dec (6sc)

Row 26: dec, 2sc, dec (4sc)

Row 27: dec, repeat (2sc)

Row 28: dec, fasten off

Crochet a second part the same way.

Decoration:

Door: ch6

Row 1 - 5: 5sc (5sc)

Row 6: dec, sc, dec (3sc) fasten off

Window (2x): ch6

Row 1 - 4: 5sc (5sc) fasten off

Chimney: ch6

Row 1 – 7: 5sc (5sc) fasten off

Assembling:

Before sewing the two parts on to each other:

Make a French knot on the door

Embroider the windows (see photo)

Make French knots in two different colors under the roof line

Place the two-house parts on top of each other and sew the sides together (leave bottom open) do not forget to place the chimney between the two parts! See photo.

Enjoy crocheting and please stay safe and stay at home!
