



Crochet pattern Christmas ornament



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Supplies:

- Cotton yarn; colors red, cream and gold
- Hook size 3 mm
- Scissors and needle
- Stitchmarker
- Piece of red ribbon to make a bow

Abbreviations (US crochet terms):

Mr = magic ring

Ch = chain

Sc = single crochet

Dc = double crochet

Hdc = half double crochet

St = stitch

R = round

Sl st = slip stitch

Inc = increase

Pattern:

First part:

With red yarn.

R1: 11 hdc in magic ring, close R with sl st in first hdc.

(11hdc)

R2: ch2 (counts as one hdc), hdc in same st. (2hdc in every st around, join with sl st in 2nd ch of initial ch2. (22hdc)

Fasten off and sew the ends.

Second part:

With gold colored yarn.

Repeat R1 and 2 of the first part

R3: now we join part 1 and 2, next sts you make you should pass your hook through sts of part 1 and part2.

Place part 1 on part 2

Ch2 (counts as one hdc), hdc in same st as ch2, hdc in next st, (2hdc, hdc) repeat () sl st in 2nd ch of initial ch2. (33hdc)

R4: ch1 (counts as one sc), sc in same st. sc in next st, sc in next st (2sc in next st, 2sc) repeat (). (44sc) Fasten off.



Third part:

With gold yarn.

R1: 22 hdc in magic ring

(or: ch9, close with sl st and crochet 22hdc in the ring), join R with sl st to form a circle. **Pull the yarn to close the whole but leave a space. The whole should measure about 1.5 cm (diameter) (22hdc) (see photo 3)**

R2: ch2 (counts as one hdc), hdc in same st, hdc in next st.

(2hdc, hdc) repeat () sl st in 2nd ch of initial ch2. (33hdc)

R3: ch1 (counts as 1sc), sc in same st, sc in next st, sc in next st (inc, 2sc) repeat () (44sc) fasten off.



Now we are joining the parts

Attach cream colored yarn:

Place the two parts on top of each other.

R4: ch1 (counts as 1sc), sc in next 43 sts;

make sure to pass your hook through both parts.

Now both parts are joined. In the last sc make a hanging loop: ch14 and sl st in next st. fasten off. (44sc)

Use a needle and piece of gold yarn and make some sts in the top of the heart to shape the red part into a heart.

You can also place a stitch at the bottom of the heart to make the heart shape sharper. Sew in the ends.

Embroider some sts in a circle with red yarn.



Decorate as you like. I made a red bow and sew it to the top.

Done is your Christmas ornament!

Nice to decorate a tree or as a small Christmas gift for a loved one.



Option ornament 2 (quick option):

Make the first 2 parts. After R4: attach new color (or glitter yarn) and crochet an extra R of sc. Make a loop (sc14) in last sc. Fasten off. Glue or sew a nice Christmas charm to the ornament.
