



Pattern Frida egg cosy



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It's a way for me to continue designing more FREE patterns and share with you.

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Materials:

You can use any cotton yarn from your stash with suitable hook size
I used cotton yarn and hook size 2,5 mm (hook size 3,00 mm for the hair)
Fiberfill
Scissors and needle
Optional: textile glue

Abbreviations (US)

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dec = decrease
inc = increase
BLO = back loop only
Sl st = slip stitch
St = stitch
Sts = stitches
Hdc = half double crochet
Dc = double crochet

Note: pattern is based on an egg cup. Length of the dress is depending on the size of your egg cup.

Pattern

Base: (dress) Measure size of dress on your egg cup

R1: with pink color; 6sc in magic ring (6)

R2: inc 6 x (12)

R3: (inc, sc) repeat (18)

R4: (inc, sc2) repeat (24)

R5: 24sc (24)

R6: (inc, sc5) repeat (28)

R7: (inc, 6sc) repeat (32)

R8: (inc, 7sc) repeat (36)

R9: (inc, 5sc) repeat (42)

R10 – 18: 42sc (42) measure size on your egg cup

R19: Change to color white, **BLO**; ch3, 3dc in same st, skip next st, sl st in next st (4dc in next st, skip next st, sl st in next st) repeat () around. Fasten off.



Head:

R1: with skin color; 6sc in magic ring (6)

R2: inc 6 x (12)

R3: (inc, sc) repeat (18)

R4: (inc, sc2) repeat (24)

R5: (inc, sc3) repeat (30)

R6: (inc, sc4) repeat (36)

R7: (inc, 5sc) repeat (42)

R8-14: 42sc (42)

R15: (dec, 5sc) repeat (36)

R16: (dec, 4sc) repeat (30)

R17: (dec, 3sc) repeat (24)

R18: (dec, 2sc) repeat (18) stuff the head

R19: (dec, sc) repeat (12)

R20: dec 6x (6) fasten off and weave yarn through last sts.



Embroider Eyes, eyebrows and mouth before sewing the hair (wig) to the head.

Hair:

Use hook size 3,00 mm for the hair or work looser sts with hook size 2,5 mm.

R1: with black color; 6sc in magic ring (6)

R2: inc 6 x (12)

R3: (inc, sc) repeat (18)

R4: (inc, sc2) repeat (24)

R5: (inc, sc3) repeat (30)

R6: (inc, sc4) repeat (36)

R7: (inc, 5sc) repeat (42)

R8-11: 42sc (42) try on the wig, if it's too short, add another round.

R12: sl st, 3hdc, 3dc, 2dc in next st, 2dc, 1hdc, sl st, 1hdc, 2dc, 2dc in next st, 3dc, 3hdc, sl st. fasten off. Glue or sew the wig to the head.

Braid:

With black color, ch150 fasten off. Fold the chain and wrap like a braid (see photo). Sew or glue around the head on R11.

Flower and leaves:

Flower:

Ch9

Skip 1, (3hdc, sl st) in every st. wrap and fold in flower shape.

Leaf:

Ch6

Sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc along chain. On the other side of chain; sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc, sl st and fasten off.



Sew or glue flowers and leaves to the head. Make as many flowers and leaves as you like.

Shawl:

Ch34 (leave a tail at the beginning and end to tie a bow later)

R1: dc, skip 2sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in the same st, skip 2 sts, repeat till end of R, dc, turn

R2: dc, ch2, dc in same st, (dc, ch2, dc) in gap between 2 dc's (the v) of previous R, dc in last dc, ch2, dc. Fasten off. Wrap the shawl around Frida and tie a bow with the yarn tails.
