



Pattern little crown:

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Materials:

Yarn: Durable Coral and Durable Glam

Hook size 3 mm

Stuffing

Abbreviations (US)

ch chain

sc single crochet

dec decrease

inc increase

picot ch2, sl st in second ch from the hook

The crown is crocheted in rows. **Turn after every row and start the row with ch1.**

The crown consists of two parts which you crochet together using sc and Durable Glam yarn.

Stuff the crown before you close. (or don't stuff if you want to use it for example as a garland).

Pattern

Crown (2x):

Ch 15

(from now crochet ch1 after every row and turn)

R1: 14sc (14sc)

R2 – 6: 14sc (14sc)

R7: inc, 12sc, inc (16sc)

R8 – 10: 16sc (16sc)

Now we start with the first point of the crown

Row 11: 4sc

R12: 4sc

R13: 2sc, dec (3sc)

R14: 3sc (3sc)

R15: sc, dec (2sc)

R16: 2sc (2sc)

R17: dec (1sc) fasten off



Middle point of the crown:

Attach yarn in the last st of R11 first point (photo), ch1

R1: 8sc (8sc)

R2: 8sc (8sc)

R3: dec, 4sc, dec (6sc)

R4: 6sc (6sc)

R5: dec, 2sc, dec (4sc)

R6: 4sc (4sc)

R7: dec 2 x (2sc)

R8: 2sc (2sc)

R9: dec (1sc) fasten off

Third point of the crown:

Attach yarn in last st of middle point R11, ch1

R1: 4sc (4sc)

R2: 4sc (4sc)

R3: dec, 2sc (3sc)

R4: 3sc (3sc)

R5: dec, sc (2sc)

R6: 2sc (2sc)

R7: dec (1sc) fasten off

Assembling:

Place the two parts together and crochet around with sc.

Sc 2, picot, sc1 in the top points of the crown. Make hanging loop in the middle point of the crown.
